1. A randomized comparative experiment tests whether pet therapy affects the mood scores of hospital patients. The mood scores range from 1 to 10, with scores close to 10 indicating a good mood. The control group has eight patients and the treatment group, which receives the pet therapy, has eight patients. The table shows the results.

Control Group	1	4	2	3	8	5	4	2
Treatment Group	3	9	4	7	3	6	2	9

- Find the mean score of the treatment group.
- Find the experimental difference of the means.
- Display the data in a double dot plot.
- What can you conclude?
- Resample the data using a simulation.
- Find the mean score of the new control group.
- Find the mean score of the new treatment group.
- Find the experimental difference of the new means.
